### What is human trafficking?

Human trafficking presents:

- recruitment,
- purchase,
- sales,
- handover,
- transport,
- encouraging or mediating in purchase, sale or delivery,
  - providing shelter and reception of persons,

and it is used in doing so:

- threat,
- force,
- abduction,
- fraud,
- abuse of position or authority

### WHY HUMANS ARE TRAFFICKED?

In purpose of exploiting people for:

- forced and irregular work,
- begging,
- false adoptions,
- fake and forced marriage
- pornography,
- forced prostitution
- "sex tourism and entertainment,
- human organs trafficking

### WHO ARE HUMAN TRAFFICKERS?

Traffickers can be anyone, including your acquaintances, friends and relatives.

### HUMAN TRAFFICKING CYCLE

1. Recruitment (acquaintance, ads)
2. Transport (production or forgery of documents, border crossing)
3. Exploitation of a person (breaking resistance, control mechanism, abuse, violence, addiction, threats, debt bondage)

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## WHEN TO SUSPECT IN HUMAN TRAFFICKING?

- when offering and advertising attractive business offers without references,
- when offering a well-paid job without prior discussion with the responsible person about qualifications, contract, work experience, etc.,
- emphasizing urgency and excellent earnings when hiring,
- unclear and unverifiable information about the “employer”.

## HOW TO REACT WHEN YOU DOUBT IN HUMAN TRAFFICKING?

If you notice a tempting advertisement for a well-paid job at home or abroad, even though the offer seems legal, because “human trafficking happens in another case” in each case you need:

- Make contact with employers, inquire about their references.
- Perform available checks on the employer, use open sources when collecting data.
- Have an interview with the employer regarding the conditions of employment, earnings, payment of contributions.
- Request a copy and clarification of the employment contract.
- Do not allow other people to deal with administrative issues related to employment.
- Master the basics of a foreign language in case of going abroad.
- Make copies of personal documents.
- Give the travel document only to authorized officials.
- In case the future employer does not want to allow you some of the above things, justifying himself in various ways, give up from that possible job, no matter how tempting it seemed!

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
